

POLICE RESPONSIBILITIES

Basic duties of the Police are maintenance of Law and Order, prevention and detection of crime, traffic management and enforcement of various laws of the land. Here are the core responsibilities of the police:

1. **Law Enforcement:** Enforcing laws, regulations, and ordinances; apprehending individuals who violate them.

4. **Investigation:** Conducting investigations into crimes, gathering evidence, interviewing witnesses, and collaborating with other agencies.
5. **Emergency Response:** Responding promptly to accidents, natural disasters, medical emergencies, and other urgent situations.
6. **Community Engagement:** Building trust with the community through outreach, communication, and programs that address public concerns and needs.
